

Mosaic Hat – taught by Kim Pate

This hat pattern is a great introduction to colorwork without the headache of the tangles of stranded colorwork! This is the hat that I recently posted on the fb page.

Date - Wednesday, November 7 and 14, 6-8pm

Class cost – \$35

Materials needed – 2 skeins of ww yarn (suggested yarns – Malabrigo Rios, Berroco Ultra Alpaca, Berroco Ultra Wool, Cascade 220 SW Merino), 1 skein should be medium/dark color and the other skein should be light colored (you will be able to get 2 hats by reversing the colors)

- #8 16” circular needles
- #8 24” circular needles (or a pair of #8 DPN’s)
- stitch markers (for marking beginning of round)
- darning needle (for weaving in ends)

Pre-requisites – MUST know how to knit in the round

What will you learn? – How to knit mosaic style using 1 color per row
- How to read a Mosaic pattern

Please have all materials purchased and yarn wound before class starts.
